HAZARDOUS WASTE PRECLUSION



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Regulatory Requirements

Criterion 7 of Section 39.2 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act and of the City of Zion Pollution Control Facility Siting Ordinances requires if the Facility will be treating, storing or disposing of hazardous waste, an emergency response plan exists for the Facility which includes notification, containment, and evacuation procedures to be followed in case of an accidental release.

The Site 2 East expansion of the Veolia E.S. Zion Landfill will not knowingly accept, treat, store, or dispose of hazardous waste. Veolia E.S. Zion Landfill, Inc. will comply with all federal and state regulations pertaining to the handling and disposal methods of waste at the Facility.

Waste Screening Process/ Emergency Response Plan

The Site 2 East expansion of the Veolia E.S. Zion Landfill does not intend to accept, treat, store, or dispose of hazardous waste as defined by the Illinois Environmental Protection Act. Veolia E.S. Zion Landfill, Inc. has implemented a comprehensive load checking plan as described in the Operating Plan (Section 2.6) to reduce the potential for hazardous waste to be accepted. Veolia maintains a Emergency Preparedness Plan to be followed in the event of an accidental release. The closed Site 1 Phase A Co-Disposal site, located at the Facility, also has an Emergency Response Plan. Please refer to Section 2.6 for the complete operating plan, and Appendix Q for a copy of the Emergency Preparedness Plan.

Therefore, the proposed Facility satisfies Criterion 7.
